

Getting to Cornell


Driving

Use your favorite mapping web site – the address for the Alice Cook parking lot is **709 University Ave, Ithaca, NY 14853**

Unloading and Picking up Your Parking Permit

Once on University, watch for signage. Turn off of University and enter the circle driveway on the side of **Alice Cook House**. Pull into the drive, drop off your luggage, pick-up your parking permit. Staff will instruct you where you can park after unloading. Please note: The parking is not close to your residence hall. Please be sure to be prepared to walk a short distance. A small shuttle will also be available throughout the registration day from parking lot to luggage drop off locations, however this is not guaranteed. We will have carts available to help transport luggage once you have checked in and received your room key and registration packet at the Carl Becker House.

When returning to the drop off point, the staff will direct you to the Carl Becker House to check-in and receive your keys. Your luggage will be taken to the dorm for you by the staff. Depending on what time you arrive, either someone will be there, or there will be signage posted on the door with a phone number to call for assistance.



To and from New York City

The [Short Line Bus](#) service from the Port Authority Bus Terminal in midtown Manhattan lets off near the dorms. It is a 5 hour ride. For more information:

To and from the Ithaca Airport (ITH)

Taxis serve the Ithaca airport and can be summoned with a phone at the airport ground transportation desk, or by calling +1.607.277.7777. Fares are based on zone rather than by meter, and are charged *per destination address*. Service to Cornell should cost about \$15-20 plus tip; you should have cash since credit cards are not necessarily accepted. If the driver does not know Carl Becker House, it is near the corner of West Ave. and Campus Rd., or near Baker Flag Pole. The trip takes about 10-15 minutes.

Depending on your arrival/departure time, a cheaper (though slower) option may be the public transit [TCAT bus](#). Routes [32 \(weekdays\)](#) and [72 \(weekends\)](#) serve the airport and the Cornell campus. Check the schedule first, since this route is fairly infrequent, and may not run late at night. For the 32 the best stop to use on the campus is [Sage Hall \(coming into campus\) / Statler Hall \(departing campus\)](#) which is about a 5 minute walk from the Carl Becker House; the 72 stops at Baker Flag Pole. The fare is \$1.50. The trip takes 20-30 minutes plus waiting time.

To and from the Syracuse airport (SYR)

[Ithaca Airline Limousine](#) provides transportation between SYR and Ithaca. You must reserve a spot at least 48 hours in advance by calling the phone number +1.607.273.3030 and paying with a credit card. The Baker Flag Pole stop on West Campus is very close to the Carl Becker House. They are rather expensive and as of this writing charge \$80 one way or \$110 round trip. The trip takes about 90 minutes.
